They started penny trails and it is believed these coins were melted down and added to the metal used to cast the bell. The first ship was renamed Zealandia in 1911 when NZ purchased a battle cruiser to bear the country's name. The bell was transferred to HMS New Zealand upon its commissioning in 1912, partly due to the efforts of Commander R.C. Davenport who was aboard both the Zealandia and HMS NZ [see documentation]. Was originally hung from a copper Maori head. Bell has a large crack which has been repaired. Maori decorative design has been partially worn away due to polishing.
